

1. Stole long piece of cloth worn around the shoulders. Priests wear this when celebrating mass and sacraments.

5. Green Vestment Is the color of hope and growth. It is worn during Ordinary times.

2. Alb the long white robe that the priest puts on over his clothes.

6. White Vestment - the color of purity. It is worn on all special feasts of Jesus, Mary, the angels and saints who were not martyrs. It is used for weddings and masses for the dead.

3. Cincture the cord the priest ties around his waist.

7. Gold Vestment -This is the color of celebration. It is used on great feast days like Christmas

4. Chasuble the garment put over the alb, cincture, and stole. It can be colored, which tells the type of feast we are celebrating.

8. Red Vestment- The color of fire or blood is used on the feasts of martyrs (people who died for their faith) and of the Holy Spirit.
